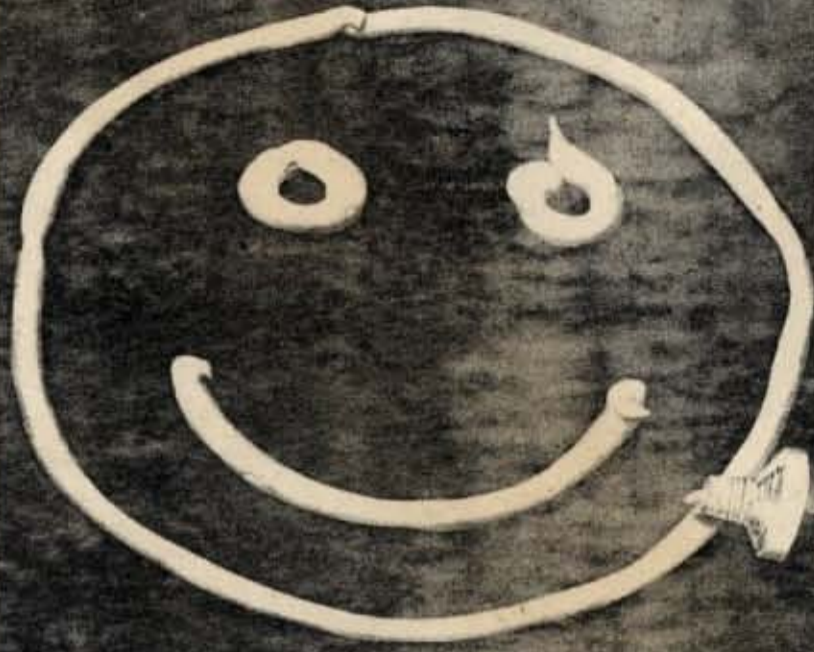

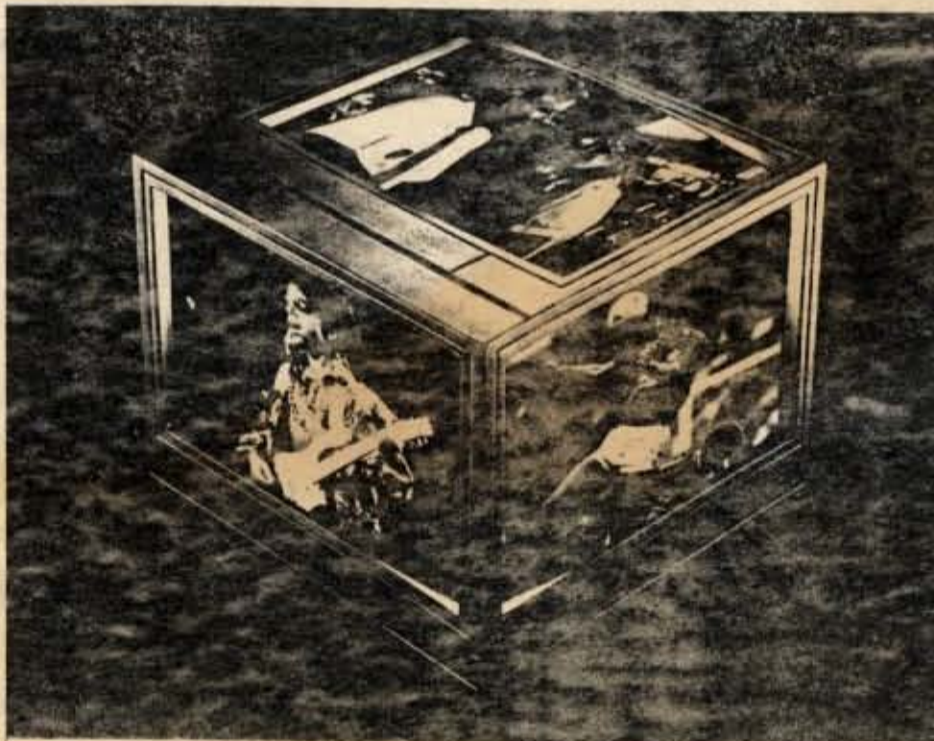
## Creative challenge

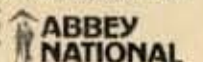
